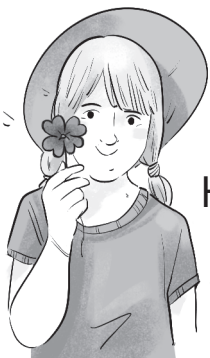
Finding a shamrock with four leaves is always lucky but on St. Patrick's Day it is twice as lucky!
